### Connection through Integration: A session by Ms. Diptee Acharya

The International Early Years Curriculum (IEYC), International Primary Curriculum (IPC), and International Middle Years Curriculum (IMYC) play important roles in fostering connected learning. This approach, emphasized in a recent workshop titled *"Connecting Learning Through Integration"* led by Director Ms. Diptee Acharya on December 24, 2023, empathized on the interdependence of learning.



The workshop facilitated the intertwining of ideas within and between subjects, reinforcing neural connections in the brain. Sanskriti's educational strategy involves constructing subjects independently yet interdependently within thematic units. This design encourages learners to engage in meaningful dialogue from diverse perspectives, allowing them to grasp the broader context of their education.

By integrating subjects and learning objectives of national and international curriculum seamlessly, learners can establish connections not only within a specific subject but also across various disciplines, enhancing their overall comprehension and critical thinking skills. Learning is interdependent through connecting ideas to and between subjects and to prior learning to current learning so that the connections in the brain are reinforced.



The session provided an invaluable platform for educators to introspect and enhance their teaching methodologies in the path of connected learning. This reflective practice centered around fundamental questions crucial for the development of a holistic educational environment:

#### **Connecting to Previous Learning:**

Teachers examined strategies to help learners build bridges to prior knowledge within and beyond their current studies. This involves creating a learning environment where past lessons are consistently

#### **Displaying Inter-Subject Links:**

Educators discussed the importance of visual and thematic displays in the classroom that illustrate the interconnectedness of different subjects. This might include concept maps, mind maps, project showcases, or thematic units that demonstrate how various subjects converge around a common theme or idea.



#### Interdisciplinary Exploration of Themes:

Teachers reflected on methods to guide learners in synthesizing knowledge from different subjects to fully investigate themes. This can be achieved through integrated projects, thematic units, or inquirybased learning where learners apply concepts from multiple disciplines to explore a central theme comprehensively.



#### Developing Diverse Viewpoints through Independent Subjects:

The session also emphasized on how learning in distinct subjects helps in cultivating varied perspectives among learners. This aspect is crucial in teaching learners to appreciate different angles and approaches within a thematic context, fostering critical thinking and problem-solving skills.



#### Articulation of Learning Connections:

A key focus was on enabling learners to articulate the subject they are studying and its interconnections with other areas of learning. This skill is vital for learners to understand the relevance and application of their learning in a broader context. Teachers discussed strategies to encourage learners to express these connections, such as reflective journals, discussions, or presentations.



Overall, the session aimed at empowering teachers of Sanskriti to create a more integrated and reflective learning environment, where learners can see the relevance of their studies in a wider, interconnected academic landscape. Gratitude to our director Ms. Diptee Acharya.





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
